

Volunteering with the 28th International U17 Youth Cycling Tour in Austria in August 2013

The 28th International U17 Youth Cycling Tour 2013 is taking place from 10th to 16th of August 2013 in Bad Tatzmannsdorf in Burgenland (Austria).

The organiser Landes-Radsport-Verband-Burgenland, in cooperation with the Austrian Ministry of Economy, Family and Youth, the Austrian Federal Economic Chamber, the European Youth Card Austria, the Austrian National Tourist Office, the bus company Dr. Richard and the Austrian Railways ÖBB

offers you an awesome all-inclusive week with young athlets from 18 nations,

and the opportunity to take part in a international youth sports event as a volunteer !

The team of 6 volunteers – 4 Austrian & 2 volunteers from neighbouring countries between 17 to 26 years old – will have the opportunity to support the organisers in different tasks:

preparation of the venue, reception and accreditation of the athlets, support for the free time programme for the international teams, interviews with VIPS and athlets, photo documentation, blog writing, ...

All costs are covered: board and lodging for 6 days, insurance, free train ride between the Austrian border and Vienna (ÖBB ticket), bus transfer from Vienna to Bad Tatzmannsdorf and back (Dr. Richard), local transport to the sports venues, free entrance to the SPA and free time programme, volunteer's start package and farewell gift.

The volunteers will be supported by promotion coaches.

Arrival of volunteers at Bad Tatzmannsdorf: 10th of August, before 13:00

Departure of volunteers: 16th of August, after the award ceremony in the afternoon.

Free shuttle service from and to Vienna is provided by bus company Dr. Richard.

If your are a EYCA-Cardholder in Czech Republic or Slovenia, between 17 and 26 years old, you can apply to your national EYCA office until 1st of July 2013.
